



Sexual Assault Advocacy Program:

designed to lead organizations to a greater understanding of sexual consent, sexual violence & intimate partner violence within culturally diverse communities. Also includes classes designed to improve outcomes for individuals who have experienced sexual violence within diverse communities.

New Alabamians Program: Crisis services are different around the world and between U.S. states. It can be life-saving to know how to navigate the emergency services in your new home country and state. Therefore, it is important to be familiar with the available crisis services in Alabama – especially if there is a language barrier.



Multi-Language Access Program:

allows survivors to communicate in their own language by providing culturally competent, trauma-informed Language Providers (interpreters/translators) to serve as their bridge with first responders and other service providers. This program also provides translation services for survivors' personal documents and other important records, as well as ensuring that AshaKiran resource materials are available in multiple languages for reaching culturally diverse communities throughout Alabama.

AshaKiran's Cross-Cultural Awareness Training (CCAT)

Program: designed for organizations working with foreign-born communities and is provided throughout Alabama. Unlike traditional cultural diversity classes, our CCAT classes & workshops provide additional understanding of the various cultural aspects involved when dealing with specific crisis issues, such as domestic violence and sexual assault, and are designed for first responders, healthcare professionals and other crisis organizations.
